Event Summary: Music Teacher Showcase

Our second annual Music Teacher Showcase was held Saturday, May 19, at Unity of the Valley. Participants included Eugene District teachers, along with guest performers, and the 2018 high school first place winners of the Beverly Soule Memorial Scholarship. We had a total of ten performers on the program, performing music in a variety of styles, and including works for voice, violin, and piano.

Our audience was considerably smaller this year. A combination of ticket sales and contributions totaled \$415. Subtracting expenses, we were able to add \$391.30 to the scholarship fund.

Our thanks to everyone who contributed to this recital: the performers who devoted time to practice and rehearsal in preparation for the recital; to the volunteers who gave so generously of their time to help the recital run smoothly, and to my co-chair, Laura DuBois.

We need to work harder to encourage our students and their families to attend this event. If only half of our membership attended, with each member bringing two additional people, we would have a full house. The Music Teacher Showcase is too good to be missed!
