SUMMER PRACTICE RECORD 2011

How to earn Extra Credit Points or Pennies during summer vacation!

- Summer piano practice. Keep a calendar or chart on the refrigerator.
 Students should practice/play the piano at least 2-3 days per week (each 5 days of practice earns a point or penny).
- Summer Concerts. We are privileged to live in an area rich in summer concerts from the Oregon Bach Festival, the Oregon Festival of American music, and concerts in the park. Enjoy a summer concert or two or more. List any concerts you attend on the back of this sheet. (1 point or penny per concert)
- 3. Lesson & theory books extra credit. For each new piece: date the piece; write in the counting; name the starting notes; circle the starting fingering and any changing fingering; clap and count; play and count. (Penny or point per page)
- 4. Music Book Report. Read one library book about a famous musician. (If you can't find one in the library, call me...... I have a selection of books in my library.) Write a short report to tell me about your composer. Listen to a CD of your composer and write about the piece. (2 points or pennies for a book report. Extra credit for the listening report.)
- 5. Summer listening: listen to Aaron Copland's Rodeo, Handel's Fireworks Music or Water Music, Mussorgsky's Pictures at an Exhibition, Mozart's Eine Kleine Nachtmusik, Haydn's Farewell Symphony, Rimsky-Korsakov's Flight of the Bumblebee, Haydn's Surprise Symphony and more. List your favorite recordings on the back of this sheet. Write a sentence or two about what you heard. (1 penny or point per piece with description.)
