After the first recital, a parent complained that students had to wait too long on the stage before beginning playing. So we decided to change the system for the last two recitals. The students waited for the adjudicator to make a sign, and only then went on stage. I think it was better. We just have to remind students to take time to adjust the bench!

Also, it took the adjudicators more than one hour to debate on the results. So it seems better to plan for the chair only to wait for the results from the adjudicators. Then the chair sends the results in the evening through Leggiero.

Unity of the Valley provided a wonderful free space for the event, hosting the Classic Piano Company's freely loaned Yamaha piano. Much thanks to them for letting Eugene OMTA enjoy free space and piano!

The Leggiero software is very friendly to use. Thanks again to Ramona for managing this software, and helping us so kindly with the use of it. I hope we will be able to manage it help free the following years! I tried to take more notes...

For next year, I would like to have more precise information about the choice for Alternate and Honorable Mention in all the guidelines on the State Website. It includes the Teacher Guidelines, the Adjudicator Guideline, and the District Chair Guidelines. I will contact the State chair about that.


