April 10, 2023 – “The Piano Music of George Walker”

Presenter: Dr. Alexandre Dossin
Location: Berwick Hall (975 E. 18th Ave)

Pianist and composer George Walker (1922-2018) was the first African-American to win the Pulitzer Prize for his piece Lilacs in 1996. In this presentation, Dr. Alexandre Dossin (Steinway Artist and UO Professor of Piano) will talk about and demonstrate Walker's musical style in his works for piano. Dr. Dossin has recently been performing George Walker's piano music around the country, and his recording of Walker's complete piano works is forthcoming.

Eugene District OMTA Meeting
Berwick Hall BOD Rm.
Monday, March 13, 2023

President RIESER called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

Attendees in-person: Nick Rieser, Grace Ho, Genevieve Mason, Alexis Gibbons, Wyatt Burger, Lucy Clevenger, Kumiko Vanderbush,

Attendees via zoom: Betsy Parker February minutes were approved. March Treasurer's report was approved. **Student Activities**

Spring District Recital: Chair: Sarah Burch. The recitals went well with a total of 36 students representing 10 teachers performing over three recitals. Nick noted that Sarah did a wonderful job of acknowledging the hard work of the students and teachers as well as highlighting the importance of piano studies especially in today's world.

There was discussion of needing to review with students both the time limit allowed to perform as well the importance of being prepared.

A discussion of Leggiero was also raised since there were scheduling adjustments needed which could not be accommodated by Leggiero. Nick said he plans to correspond with the State OMTA regarding the challenges that teachers have had with Leggiero for some time.

Although there are benefits to Leggiero, it was designed for Syllabus and so does not allow for teachers to specify repertoire details. As a result, Sarah had to type the programs by hand. Out of the \$367.50 raised by the Spring District Recital, \$140.00 was spent on Leggiero which is especially important to consider given that the programs still had to be typed by hand.

Future venues were also discussed since the Kawai at St. Paul's posed some challenges including the action, tuning, and the sound up close as well as reverberation at the back of the hall. The cost for St. Paul's was \$150.00.

Piano UO Festival: To be held on Sunday, April 30 1:00-6:00 pm at the UO School of Music and Dance. Registration deadline is April 14. The theme is character pieces.

Composition Festival: The video comprised of compositions and student discussion has been produced and will be shown on May 6 at 4:00 at the Broadway Metro. Teachers and students are invited to attend the viewing.

In addition, Rob Tobias, who produced the video might be interested in using the video for promotional purposes with the permission of the Eugene District OMTA. All in attendance at the meeting were in favor of using the video for promotional purposes.

Discussion of potential future fundraising event:

Since Barnes and Noble is no longer viable for our annual winter fundraising play-a-thon due to their donation restructuring, should we consider finding a new location to hold this type of festive winter fundraising event? Perhaps we could consider adding such an event next year.

Nick will poll our membership to gauge interest to determine if we should pursue this. Alexis would be willing to chair once we determine if and where we plan to hold such an event.

Website:

Nick and Alexis need one more person to join their committee. They are in the process of implementing Trello to serve as an electronic post-it board for teachers to post information on upcoming events.

Managing the website is a top priority right now. To offer input or to help, please contact Neil or Ellen.

Membership: We have a new member, Bokyoung Lee, who is looking for new students. Since he is just beginning to establish his studio and it is the beginning of Spring Term, it was proposed that Eugene District OMTA sponsor his membership fees until July by paying for half of his membership dues which would be \$75.00. He will need to pay for the full dues amount and then can submit a form for reimbursement for \$75. All were in favor.

Future recital venue discussion:

The issue of recital venues needs to be discussed. Genevieve proposed possible fundraising to cover venue fees. This discussion will be taken up at future meetings.
