An important contemporary American composer will be the topic as Alma Marianos of Salem presents a program on **Robert Muczynski Revisited.**

Her lecture-demonstration will include a performance of the Six Preludes, Op. 6. She will discuss other repertoire including pieces suitable for younger students, giving information about stylistic and technical considerations.

Alma Marianos began her music studies in Cairo, Egypt at the Conservatoire Tiegerman where she received a Licentiate in Performance from the Royal Schools of Music. She also obtained a degree in English Literature from the American University in Cairo. After moving to Oregon she continued her music studies with Nellie Tholen, then completed a Bachelor's Degree in Music at Oregon State University while studying with Rachelle McCabe. As a resident of Cannon Beach she appeared frequently as soloist and musician with the North Coast Chamber Orchestra. Now a resident of Salem she is State and nationally certified, maintains a large independent piano studio, and is an active member of OMTA.


