Beverly Soule Scholarship Award, 2012

The deadline for the third annual Beverly Soule Memorial Scholarship auditions is Monday, April 9. Our tentative date for the auditions this year is Saturday, May 5. Students are required to perform from memory three pieces representing three of the five style periods, Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impressionist and Contemporary; total time is not to exceed 20 minutes. One award of \$250 will be given with Honorable Mention(s) also selected. Honored students will be invited to the OMTA meeting in June to perform.
