During this past Sunday's recitals, I said goodbye to a graduating high school senior that has been in my studio since she was eight years old. Before that, I taught two of her older siblings. I've been involved with this family for perhaps 13 years, and not just with music. One family member went through a season of depression, once ending up on my doorstep at 2:00 in the morning with suicidal thoughts. I have broken bread in their home, delivered my kids there for babysitting, held practice recitals in their living room, and had long conversations about the challenges of parenting with their parents. I have laughed so much with these students, and shared life with them, not just music.

And this has made the music all the more rich and real. My studio won't be the same, somehow.

Of course, now there are grandkids appearing, so, who knows?

Be encouraged. Love your students well. Keep making music together!

(And get some rest this Summer. You've earned it!)


